

Player Waivers

Waivers are signed by following a web link that is sent to you via email or text message. Here is an example of what to expect. Complete your waiver by following the web address in the messages. **You only need to complete 1 waiver.** You may only receive 1 of these messages. This is fine, you only need one.
